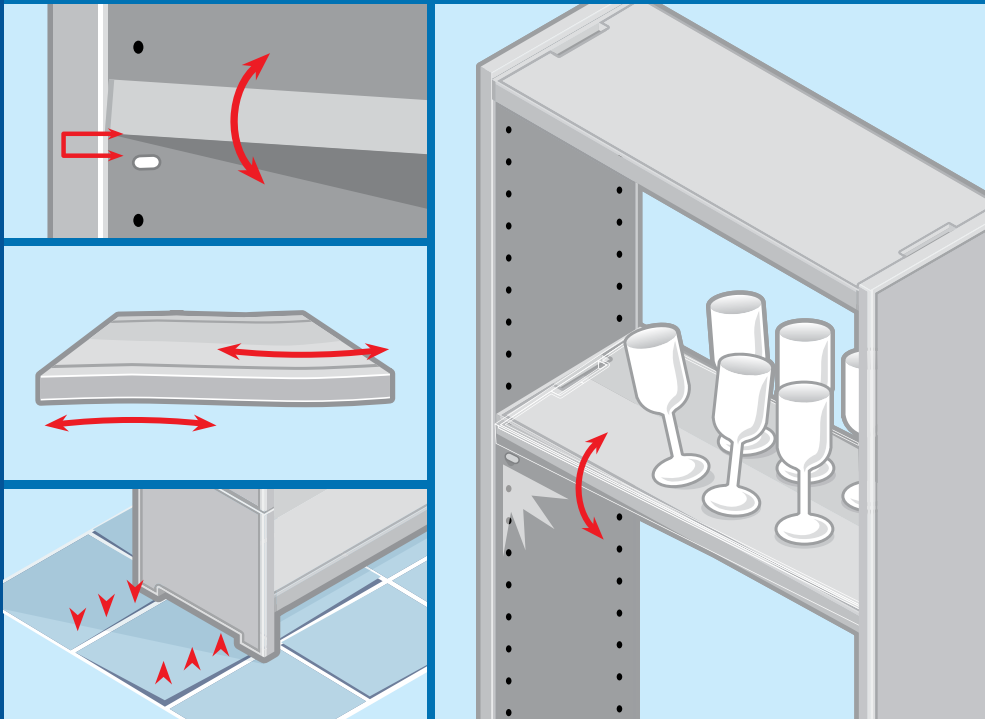




the problem

Shelves are notoriously difficult to assemble perfectly due to variables that are difficult to control. Even when using accurate drills, unstable and uneven shelves are common during installation. Moreover, it is not uncommon to find uneven shelves months or years after installation due to wear and tear, warping wood, uneven floors or inaccuracies in installation or care.

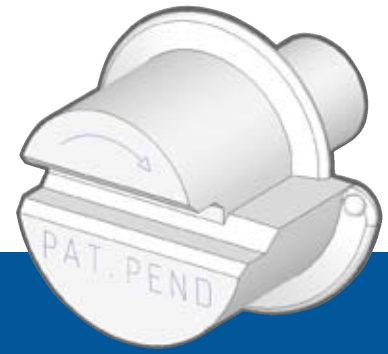

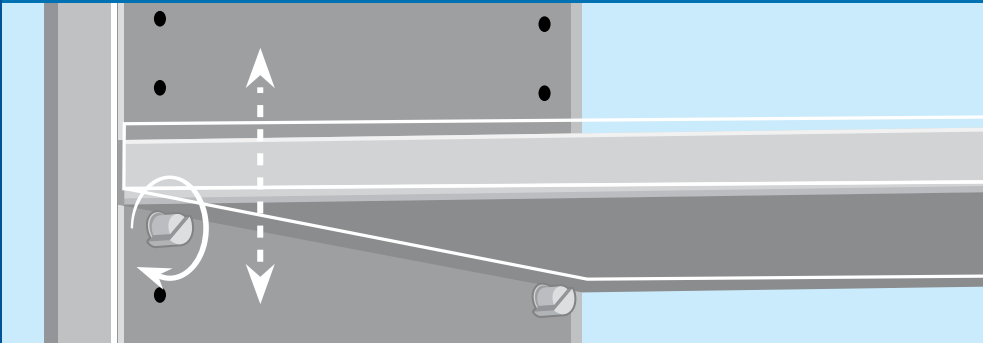

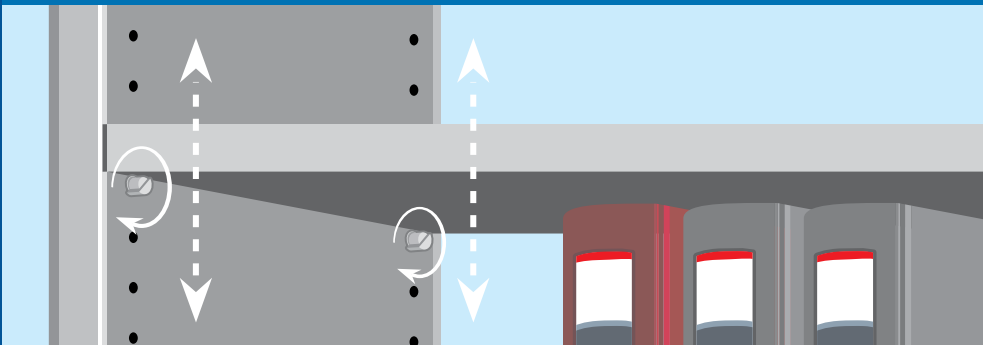
